Get to know the coaches!

Coach Luke Houdek has coached his second year as varsity boy's basketball coach at HCS. Previous coaching includes the boy's basketball program at Central Wisconsin Christian Schools in Waupun, WI and the men's basketball team at Trinity Christian College in Palos Heights, IL. While at TCC, their team won the first CCAC conference championship and earned the first trip to the NAIA division II National Tournament in the history of that school. Luke also played basketball at the junior college level for UW-Fond du Lac.

Coach Kim Miller has had a variety of coaching experiences in volleyball working with many different ages and skill levels. She has coached at the middle school and high school levels for 10 years, and will be directing this camp for the fifth time. This camp will be an excellent chance for young athletes to experience the sport for the first time and to build their skills and knowledge of the game in a fun atmosphere.

Coach Kent Millen is in his 5th year of coaching Middle School soccer. In his coaching career, his teams have won the MACC championship twice while being runner-up once. His is an HCS alum who played 4 years while in high school and one year at Judson College.
