Get to know the coaches!

Coach Terry Bennett has had a lengthy career as an athlete and coach. He led his college team as conference MVP and All-American to the conference championship. 2008-09 was his first year as Varsity Girls' coach at HCS. He led the team to a 18-4 record and a Midwest Classic Conference Championship. Coach Bennett has coached at the college, high school, and club level. Coach B. loves the Lord and loves to coach basketball!

Coach Kim Miller has had a variety of coaching experiences in volleyball working with many different ages and skill levels. She has coached at the middle school and high school levels for 10 years, and will be directing this camp for the fifth time. This camp will be an excellent chance for young athletes to experience the sport for the first time and to build their skills and knowledge of the game in a fun atmosphere.
